I have considered the report dated 21 September 2015 by Gardner Planning Ltd on behalf of OXAGE and fully support the opinions and arguments set out in that report.

I do not accept the basis used by OCC in the Strategy document for arriving at the Local Aggregate Assessment (LAA) and consider that it is substantially overstated. I consider that the LAA should be based on the 10 year average of mineral sales, the method previously accepted by OCC. The change of method has not justified or explained.

Had the previous method of assessing LAA been used there would be no need for new gravel extraction sites for many years.

I do not agree with the implication that the preferred new working areas would be in South Oxfordshire (paragraph 4.31 etc) when there appears to be no evidence to support this. As the Strategy document itself suggests that the site selection process has not been carried out these comments are not only premature but indicate that OCC has made up its mind without the need for proper review. Such paragraphs in the report should be deleted.
