1. Item for Comment/Information

Members of the committee request an update on Traded Services to schools on a annual basis.

Education Services continues to trade with schools successfully. Services are well received, and feedback from schools remains positive.

Education and Learning Services delivered by the Children, Education and Families Directorate (CEF) include:

- Governor Training
- Clerking
- OXSIT (Oxfordshire School Inclusion Service)
- Schools Health & Safety
- Early Years Offer
- Business services
- Insurance
- Employee Assistance Programmes
- Occupational Health

Total income generated from the sale of all Services has increased by 3% across the board; all services have either matched previous year or have exceeded by up to 3%, with the exception of Early Years who have reviewed their offer.

324 Schools and Early Years settings are held on the Oxfordshire Education System, of which 96% have elected to take up at least one option of the buyback services available compared to 88% the previous year. This is positive reflection of the services offered, value for money and the ease by which the system enables schools and settings to review what's on offer.

Due to continued financial pressures, we have had to review our pricing accordingly. In order to try and minimise impact, each service has been individually reviewed and priced to help ensure viability and to ensure a high-quality service can continue to be delivered. These will be discussed in Section 3 below. All pricing information will be provided online via our InSite page and in Annex A at the end of this report.

As reported last year the administration of Training and our Buyback Service has moved to Oxfordshire | Education Services. The system has provided a much more transparent and robust service by which schools can book training, as well as review and purchase the traded service offer. Other areas within OCC have started using the system, such as Education Safeguarding Advisory Team and SENSS training; plus we are in talks with the Oxfordshire Educational Psychology Service about how it could benefit them and make it a one stop for schools to see what services are available.

Purpose of Report

To provide a briefing/update on activities being carried out and to provide the details and explanation of planned charges for Education and Learning services to schools for 24/25 school year.

Explanation of Changes to Charges

OXSIT are keeping their prices the same for schools. There will also be the opportunity for schools to ask for specialist support on request. This will be agreed and charged on a case by case basis.

Early Years have reviewed their offer and as such the pricing isn't comparable, however they have looked to keep them as competitive as possible.

Schools Health and Safety are applying an increase of 2% to address inflationary and third party sub-contractor costs, e.g. play equipment, kiln and D&T inspections, radiation advisory and CLEAPSS which have all seen an increase in the last year.

Clerking Service is applying a 4.28% increase to address inflationary increases in staffing costs, and to manage fixed costs associated with the recruitment and expansion of the team.

Governor Services are applying an increase of 3% to address inflation and increasing external specialist provider costs. Governor Hub have increased their subscription rates for all schools, this is for the first time in 10 years. Oxfordshire County Council will continue to cover this cost for maintained schools.

EFS, IBC and EPS have all increased in price to OCC by an average of 2.19% which includes an assumed salary increase of 3%. Last year the salary percentage increase was higher once award agreed; with this in mind, along with that the fact there will be fewer schools due to Academy conversions, we are proposing an increase of 3% to help manage the risk and keep costs neutral.

Insurance is applying an increase of 16.76% in total (this being 16.54% on Property and 16.86% on Liability). This is a national issue and largely based on the financial markets as well as increased costs of claims due to increased compensation payments and increased costs of repairs. This increase is in line with other local authorities.

With regards to the Employee Assistance Programmes and Occupational Health. The current OH contract and EAP have been extended until June 2024 – each year this increases in line with RPI, so in order to keep costs neutral it has been agreed to increase by 3%.

Impacts on Schools

We anticipate schools will continue to find the services of a high standard and value for money.
