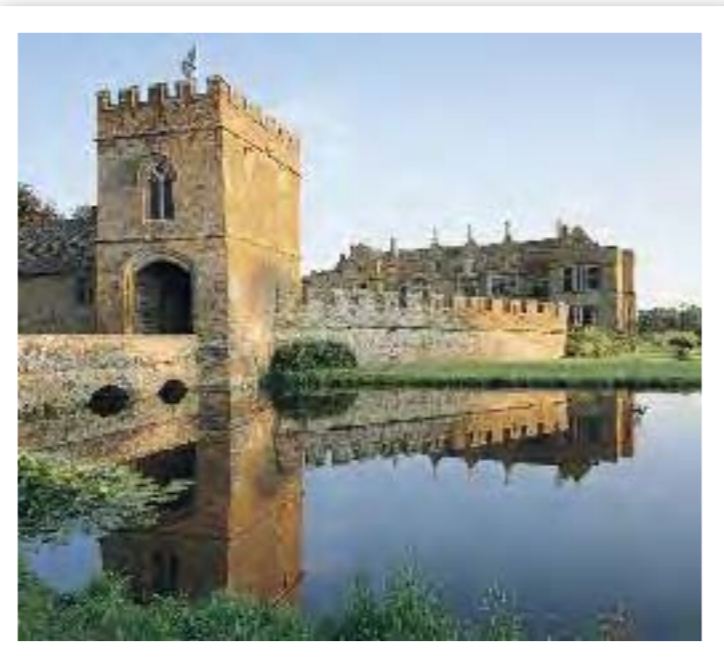

History and Heritage

Whether you are admiring the mysterious White Horse, discovering fossils in Kirtlington Quarry or exploring the Rollright Stones, you will feel part of an ancient landscape here in Oxfordshire.

Castles have featured largely in the history of Oxfordshire. **Wallingford Castle**, a Norman stronghold for a town once more important than Oxford, now lies in ruins, while **Broughton Castle** near Banbury, featured in *Shakespeare in Love*, is still a family home surrounded by a wide moat and parkland and exhibits an excellent 17th century *Arms and Armour* display. **Oxford Castle Unlocked** situated in the heart of Oxford reveals the city's hidden history; including tales of great escapes, betrayal and romance – all within the walls of this ancient castle and prison.

Kelmscott Manor, an idyllic Cotswold former manor farm, was the summer home of **William Morris**, poet, craftsman and socialist, and commemorates his life and work. **Sulgrave Manor** holds particular interest for American visitors as **George Washington's** ancestors lived there.



Visit Britain's Greatest Palace – **Blenheim Palace** and marvel at its sheer beauty while wandering through stunning parklands and award-winning formal gardens. This magnificent Palace is the ancestral home of the **Dukes of Marlborough**. It was a gift from **Queen Anne** and a grateful nation to the 1st Duke following his famous victory at the **Battle of Blenheim** in 1704 and it is also famed as the birthplace of **Sir Winston Churchill**.

Oxford the city of dreaming spires will surprise and enchant you, with its magnificent architecture, impressive yet intimate colleges and romantic rivers.

The city's 'town' and 'gown' clashes created the architecture of many colleges whose high walls and towers surround peaceful quadrangles and secret gardens. The daily **Official Guided Walking Tours** are a delightful introduction to the city and University's past, illustrated with enthralling and amusing anecdotes.

The University's five museums, including the splendid **Ashmolean**, house unique collections of art, sculpture, musical and scientific instruments, natural history specimens and artefacts from around the world which have become part of Oxford's heritage.

One visit will not be enough!

The Extraordinary Gardens of Oxfordshire

Oxfordshire is a gardeners' delight all year round.

Oxfordshire's gardens come in all shapes and sizes, colours and scents, created in different centuries for diverse purposes. Some are the first, the best, or the only remaining ones of their kind.

Oxford's Botanic Garden, the first in Britain (1620), was intended as a 'Physick Garden' to investigate herbal remedies; its riverside setting gives splendid views of passing punts on the River Cherwell.

Visit the splendour and tranquillity of 'Capability' Brown's landscape at **Blenheim Palace**. Wander to the Secret Garden with its secluded paths and winding stream or visit the newly landscaped banks which overlook the beautiful Cascade. Take time out to smell the roses in the stunning Rose Garden from where you can find stunning views of the Great Lake.

Waddesdon Manor has one of the finest Victorian gardens in Britain, famous for its Parterre, seasonal displays, shady walks and views, fountains and statuary. The garden is renowned for its innovative planting schemes and restoration of major Victorian features such as three-dimensional carpet bedding. It also contains a small but important collection of contemporary sculpture.

Set deep in the heart of the Oxfordshire countryside, **Waterperry Gardens** have been a source of inspiration and a gardeners' delight for more than 75 years. Among the many highlights are a classical herbaceous border, formal, rose and alpine gardens and a lily canal. You can also enjoy a gentle stroll along the River Thames to end your visit.

Picnic among the peacocks at **Harcourt Arboretum** or sit quietly among the roses at **Rousham**, an oasis of tranquillity, or amble among the ponds, cascades and statues in the wondrous landscape.

Discover the surprising gardens lying behind high college walls in Oxford. Every one is unique, many with sculptures by famous artists. One has a lake, another a deer park – and **Christ Church** has a whole Meadow.

Oxfordshire is a glorious splendour of colour whatever time of year you decide to visit.

Family Fun

Families, to their pleasure, discover an enormous variety of things to see and do in Oxfordshire.

Cotswold Wildlife Park is a must with over 250 different species including rhinos, camels, lions, leopards, crocodiles and giant tortoises. You can even get up close and personal with the animals in the walk-through lemur enclosure.

At **Blenheim Palace** youngsters head for the adventure playground in the Pleasure Gardens or ride the miniature train. Families can play on the giant board games, putting green or visit the Butterfly House – something for all at the Palace!

You can ride the magnificent **Great Western Railway** at Didcot or find your way out of the Maize Maze at **Millets Farm**.

Take a trip to **Oxford Castle Unlocked** and meet the inhabitants – be careful not to upset the Prison Warden as he holds the keys! Or hop on the **open top bus** and see the delights of what Oxford has to offer!

Looking to relax with the family, then take a **river cruise** on one of the steamers in Oxford or Henley, or if you fancy something a little more energetic, then **punting** or **rowing** could be for you!

But that's just for starters...



Great local produce and fantastic restaurants can be found across Oxfordshire.

Tempting and Delicious

Eating out and sampling local produce is a great way to explore the county and meet the locals.

From **elegant dining** in historic manors and halls to friendly **pub lunches** round an open wood fire, there's an eatery to please all tastes.

Look out for restaurants focused on **traditional British fare** like pies, roasts or bangers and mash, and serving local lamb and beef; or traditional **tea shops** serving home-made cakes and afternoon teas.

The **farmers' markets** are second to none throughout the county offering fresh Oxfordshire produce and not forgetting the **Oxford Covered Market** offering a wondrous range of food from wild boar to Isis Cheese.

Cuisines from around the world thrive, sometimes in unexpected locations – like the picturesque **old inns** along the old stagecoach routes to London.

With nationally renowned **real ale breweries**, **microbreweries**, an award-winning **vineyard**, **orchards** producing fresh apple juice, and spring water drawn from a Palace well, Oxfordshire's the destination of choice for 'foodies' of all persuasions.

Shopping

Bicester Village, home to over 130 designer outlet boutiques, is the destination of choice for many, offering up to 60% off previous seasons' collections from the world's leading brand names.

But Witney, Banbury and Didcot as well as Oxford – have their own shopping centres with high street names, as well as traditional family-owned department stores like **Boswells**. Scattered through bustling market squares are small independent specialist shops offering goods and services which are hard to find elsewhere, such as quilting materials, hand-dyed wool, vinyl records or bespoke footwear. Here craftspeople practise skills honed by years of experience, attracting customers from far and wide.



Farmers' markets bring colour and crowds to Oxfordshire's market towns, while the 18th century historic **Oxford Covered Market** with its independent stalls and shops caters for all your needs.

There are **farm shops**, set amidst cherry orchards and **pick your own** in abundance.

Oxfordshire's **antique shops** are dotted around our small towns and villages – and are an excellent source of family heirlooms or souvenirs.

Combine a shopping trip with an **afternoon tea** and experience a relaxing day out for all.

One of the most delightful ways to explore Oxfordshire is by bicycle with picturesque villages dotted amidst the rolling green countryside, generally sporting a village shop, tea room or pub to welcome and refresh you.

And don't forget, just about everyone in Oxford rides a bike to explore those hidden, unexpected parts of the city – or just to get around.

Walking has always been a popular pastime in Oxfordshire.
