 I give and bequeate unto my Thomas Medhopp
 my naturall sonn: ffive shillings when he cometh to age of
 ffourteen and one yearre
 I give and bequeate unto all the next
 of my naturall children ffive shillings I give so
 to be paid when care of them cometh to age as I have said
 I give and bequeate unto my Louer wife all
 the best of my goods movable and immovable whatsoever
 can be proved and known to be mine whom I make my full
 sole executour of this my last will and testament provided
 she shall discharge my debts and bring me in parte
 Also I do Intreat my Louer wife Brother Mark Drubland
 to my Louer ffriend neighbour John Carpenter to be
 my and ffriends of this my last will and testament to see
 that my will be performed in Condition Give to me: ffive
 shillings I give An Wittness wherof I the said Thomas
 Medhopp have hereunto set my hand and seale the ffourteenth
 day of Aprill in the year of our Lord god. 1674
