

**STATUTORY DECLARATION  
SECTION 31(6) of the HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

I, Lord de Mauley DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. I am and have been:

a. since 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2002 the owner of the land known as Canford Farm, formerly Common Barn Farm, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in red; and

b. since 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2002 the owner of the land known as Hulse Ground Farm, more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged in blue.

2. On the day 24<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2006 I deposited with Oxfordshire County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red and blue edging which stated that the ways coloured green on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths and that no other ways had been dedicated as highways or public rights of way over my property.

3. No additional highways or public rights of way have been dedicated over the land edged red and the land edged blue on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2006 referred to in 2. above other than those footpaths marked in green on the plan accompanying this declaration and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2006 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declaration Act 1835.
