- C. OS Map 1898 1:2500 includes Johnsons Lane and extension to Hill Road
- D. Minutes of Watlington Parish Council Footpath Committee in October 1934 listing Johnsons Lane as a Parish footpath ( No 13 )
- E. Correspondence between Watlington Parish Council and Oxfordshire County Council indicating that Johnsons Lane was being used by motor vehicles at that time ( June – September 1962 )
- F. Photograph taken on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2021 showing the entrance to Johnsons Lane from Spring Lane illustrating bollards, guard rails and a tarmac surface as evidence of some footpath maintenance

**USER EVIDENCE**

Johnsons Lane is in constant daily use as a footpath as the most direct route for residents of Spring Lane, Springfield Close and Chiltern Gardens to access the Town centre. The extension from the Town end of Johnsons Lane to Hill Road is used by residents of Watcombe Road to access the Town centre and anyone wishing to avoid the narrow pavements, heavy traffic and poor air quality of Couching Street. In addition families with small children use the extension and Johnsons Lane from the Town end to avoid crossing the car park.
