PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Oxfordshire County Council, Hailey Unrecorded Restricted Byway and North Leigh Unrecorded Restricted Byway, **Public Path Extinguishment Order 2023**

This Order is made by The Oxfordshire County Council ('the authority') under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that the restricted byways described in paragraph 1 below are not needed for public use.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situated in the parishes of Hailey and North Leigh and shown by a bold continuous line on the map attached to this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished from the date of its confirmation.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order, statutory undertakers with apparatus over/under the land described in Article 1 above shall continue to have the same rights in respect of such apparatus as they had immediately before the date of this Order.


DESCRIPTION OF WAYS TO BE EXTINGUISHED

Hailey Unrecorded Restricted Byway

The entire width of the unrecorded restricted byway in the parish of Hailey running from OS Grid Ref SP 3681 1387 (Point A on the Order plan) generally north-north-eastwards for approximately 97m to the North Leigh Parish boundary at SP 3687 1395 (Point C).

North Leigh Unrecorded Restricted Byway

The entire width of the unrecorded restricted byway in the parish of North Leigh running from the Hailey Parish boundary at OS Grid Ref SP 3687 1395 (Point C on the Order plan) generally north-eastwards for approximately 1,533m to Wilcote Road at SP 3713 1471 (Point I).
