

- d) Over each route shown by a continuous brown line, the Secretary of state for Defence recognises the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.
3. Of the above highways those described in sub-paragraphs a),b),and C), are more particularly described in the definitive statement prepared by the County Council. The routes indicate in subparagraph d) are more particularly described in detail on the plans referred to above and enclosed (In electronic Format on CD)
4. I attached a statutory declaration to be lodged with you and renewed from time to time as appropriate.
