There is a Countywide team of specially trained staff based at our offices in Abingdon, offering advice and support on any type of hearing impairment.

Staff have a wide experience of all issues related to Hearing Impairment.

Staff will make appointments to see you at the office or in your own home or talk with you via phone/text or e-mail.

What do we do?

We can advise and support people of all ages with hearing problems, including:-

- Equipment Assessment e.g. to improve your access to TV/door bell/telephone etc.
- Advice on Deaf Issues e.g. equal access to services.
- Deaf Children and their Families e.g. support regarding available options and equipment.
- Deaf Parents e.g. access to support services, equipment.

- Information on all aspects of hearing loss including: Deaf / deafened / Hard of Hearing / Dual Sensory Loss / Mental Health needs related to Deafness.
