I give and bequeath unto my Thomas Medhopp  
 my naturall sonn: ffive shillings when he come to age of  
 ffourteen and one year: I give likewise and bequeath unto all the next  
 of my naturall children ffive shillings I give so  
 to be paid when care of them come to age as a ffollows  
 I give and bequeath unto my Louis wife all  
 the best of my goods movable and immovable whatsoever  
 can be proved and known to be mine whom I make my full  
 sole executrix of this my last will and testament provided  
 she shall discharge my debts and bring me in parts  
 Also I do bequeath my Louis Brother Mark Drubland  
 to my Louis ffather neighbour John Carpenter to be  
 my and ffriends of this my last will and testament to see  
 that my will performed in condition Give to me: ffive  
 shillings I give An witness wherof I the said Thomas  
 Medhopp have hereunto set my hand and seal the ffourteenth  
 day of Aprile in the year of our Lord god. 1674
