Re: Quickways Cycle Routes – Marston Road Junction Surfacing CHANGE OF CLOSURE DATE

We are writing to inform you that as part of the Quickways schemes, there is a date change for the planned works at the junctions of **Edgeway Road**, **William Street**, **Ferry Road** and **John Garne Way**. The surfacing work that was programmed for overnight works on 10 – 13 October, will now be carried out overnight on 1 – 4 **November** due to impacts from the recent wet weather.

Each of the junctions listed above will be closed between the hours of 19:30 and 05:30 for one night, as outlined in the table below. Please note that actual works dates may change subject to weather or unforeseen circumstances during construction.

Access via each junction will NOT be possible whilst the work is in progress. You will need to make necessary arrangements to park elsewhere if you need to use your vehicle during this period.

Marston Road / Ferry Road	02 / 03 November 2022	Night works road closure from 19:30- 05:30. Ferry Road junction will be closed for the duration of the works, with NO vehicular access/egress except for emergencies.
