OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WATLINGTON, HIGH STREET) (PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (FILMING - SPECIAL EVENT) ORDER 2024

WHEREAS the Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") is satisfied that vehicular traffic should be temporarily prohibited for road safety reasons from proceeding in High Street to facilitate filming ("the Event") to take place in the highway.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers make the following Order.

- 1. Save as provided by Article 2 of this Order, no person shall when and where appropriate signage is in place, except under the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed or wait in part of High Street ("the Section of Road").
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to proceed in the Section of Road, insofar as the safety and progress of the Event is concerned if the vehicle is:
 - (1) being used for the purpose of police, fire or ambulance services,
 - (2) necessary for access to premises not accessible other than from the Section of Road,
 - (3) of whatever description or use and is necessary for, or in support of the Event.
- 3. The prohibition imposed by Article 1 shall apply in relation to any part of the Section of Road to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs (within the meaning of section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Watlington, High Street) (Prohibition of Through Traffic) (Filming Special Event) Order 2024 and shall come into force on 7th July 2024.
