Tips to keep you safe when visiting a Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC)

Children and animals

Children and animals should remain in vehicles at all times.



Containers

Use recycling containers correctly – don't put hands inside bottle banks. If a container looks full check whether there is another 'slot' elsewhere on the bank. If container is full leave by the side of the bank.



Driving

Follow the site speed limit and the direction of the 'one way' system. Be aware of vehicle movements on site.



Handling waste

Be careful when handling your waste especially sheets of glass, rubble, or items with sharp edges such as electrical items. Consider wearing protective gloves and sturdy footwear.



Hazardous chemicals

Please see site staff if disposing of household chemicals, flammable liquids, pesticides and compressed gases.



Lifting waste

We recommend that you only lift what you can manage from your car to the container.



No Pedestrian Access

There is a 'No pedestrian access' policy at all sites.



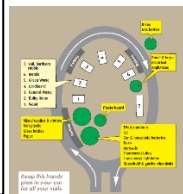
Queuing
